Chad Standifer, Assistant Attorney General representing the Staff, and Phil Stutzman, Compliance Officer, [presented](#) PDC Case 140213, Let's Go Washington (Sponsored by Brian Heywood) for alleged violations of [RCW 42.17A.235](#) & [.240](#), [WACs 390-16-037](#) and - [205](#), and [WAC 390-16-043\(9\)](#) by (1) failing to timely and accurately report the required allocation of monetary and in-kind expenditures for signature gathering and related expenditures that benefitted six separate initiatives supported by the Committee; (2) failing to timely report the expenditures of sub vendors paid by the Committee in support of six separate initiatives supported by the Committee; (3) failing to maintain and preserve books of account that substantiate expenditures incurred by sub vendors paid by the Committee in support of six separate initiatives supported by the Committee; and (4) failing to timely produce campaign records when requested by PDC Staff.
