	 Ms. Sun-Widrow confirmed that the Pollution Control and Shorelines Hearings Boards made no payments to Olympia Internal Medicine Associates, LLC during calendar year 2021.
	 Ms. Sun-Widrow attested that she has no personal knowledge of the medical practice's clients or their reportable business and governmental customers as the information is confidential and not publicly available.
Other Issues	Ms. Sun-Widrow has agreed to recuse herself if a matter came before her involving a conflict of interest between Olympia Internal Medicine Associates, LLC and the Pollution Control Hearings Board or Shorelines Hearings Board.
