Each property description must be followed by the name of the county in which the property is located. | Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer) | Ann Davison is requesting a retroactive reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing her personal residential address on her Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report), during the twelve months prior to her becoming a candidate in 2021, 2020 and 2019, due to safety concerns. In her application, Ms. Davison stated that she is concerned about the information she previously disclosed as a candidate for public office, her current elected position as the City Attorney of the City of Seattle and the information being utilized to cause harm to her. |
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| Other Issues | Ms. Davison has agreed to recuse herself if there is a conflict of interest between her duties as an election official and her personal interests. As a current elected official, Ms. Davison is eligible to utilize the address disclosure alternative described in RCW 42.17A.710(2)(a). Ms. Davison's records would be exempt from public disclosure if the Commission finds in accordance with <u>RCW 42.17A.120</u> and <u>WAC 390-28-080</u> that disclosure of such information would present a personal risk to a reasonable person. |
