Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Brian Bogen is requesting a partial reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more to Markey Machine, SWS Equipment and Oregon Equipment Sales on his Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) covering the twelve months prior to him becoming a candidate for election year 2024.
	 Mr Bogen states that he has a 13% investment in Markey Machine.
	 Mr Bogen states that he has a 3% interest in both Oregon Equipment Sales and SWS Equipment of which he holds the position of director in both companies.
	 Mr. Bogen states that the disclosure of the business customers creates an undue hardship and competitive disadvantage.
	 Mr. Bogen states the revenue generated for these three companies is as follows: Oregon Equipment Sales - \$40,000,000 revenue, Markey Machine - \$20,000,000 revenue. SWS Equipment - \$60,000,000 revenue.

	 Mr. Bogen affirms he has no involvement with the day-to-day operation of any of these companies.
