	According to its website, Stardust Secured specializes in the research, development, and scaled manufacturing of technology for supply chain traceability, document security, and brand protection.
	<ul> <li>Ms. Gasque states that Stardust Secured has 15 to 30 employees, handles \$6 million dollars in annual sales with about 50 customers, all of which would be subject to the reporting thresholds. In addition, the customers are not listed publicly and the company maintains confidentiality agreements with all their clients.</li> </ul>
	Ms. Gasque states her husband cannot legally provide her with a list of clients as it would violate the confidential agreements they have with their clients, and it would adversely affect their competitive position.
